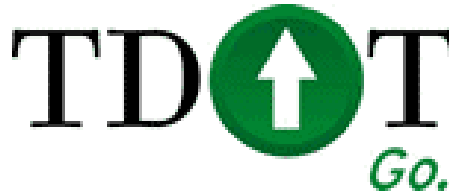

Background

The Tennessee Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), will host a **Local Roads Safety Workshop August 31st through September 3rd 2010**. This 1-day workshop will discuss TDOT's Local Roads Safety Initiative Program, introduce the Road Safety Audit Review Program and provide training on how to identify low cost safety improvements to improve safety on roads.

The intent of the **Local Roads Safety Initiative Program** is to provide assistance to local governments in Tennessee to improve safety issues on non-state routes in their jurisdictions. The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) has federal funding from the **High Risk Rural Roads Program** (23CFR 924) to administer safety projects on rural major and minor collectors and local roads where the crash rate for fatalities and incapacitating injuries exceeds the statewide average for those functional classes of roadway.

Craig Allred, Safety Specialist with the FHWA Resource Center, will lead the Road Safety Audit portion of the workshop. Mr. Allred is one of the nation's foremost experts in Road Safety Audits. Prior to working with FHWA, Mr. Allred was a Utah State Trooper and director of the Utah Governor's Highway Safety Office.

The Workshop is provided by the Accelerating Safety Activities Program (ASAP) grant from the Federal Highway Administration with **no registration cost** to the attendees.

What are Road Safety Audits?

Road Safety Audits (RSAs) is a technique used to provide an examination of a future or existing roadway by an independent, qualified audit team. The RSA is a way for your agency to improve safety and to communicate to the public how you are working toward crash reductions. This course includes topics such as:

- Why care about safety?
- Stages of a Road Safety Audit
- Details on how to conduct a Road Safety Audit
- Easy-to-use-checklists
- Legal considerations
