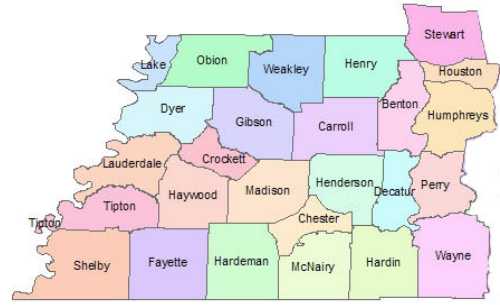

Shelby County Seat - Memphis

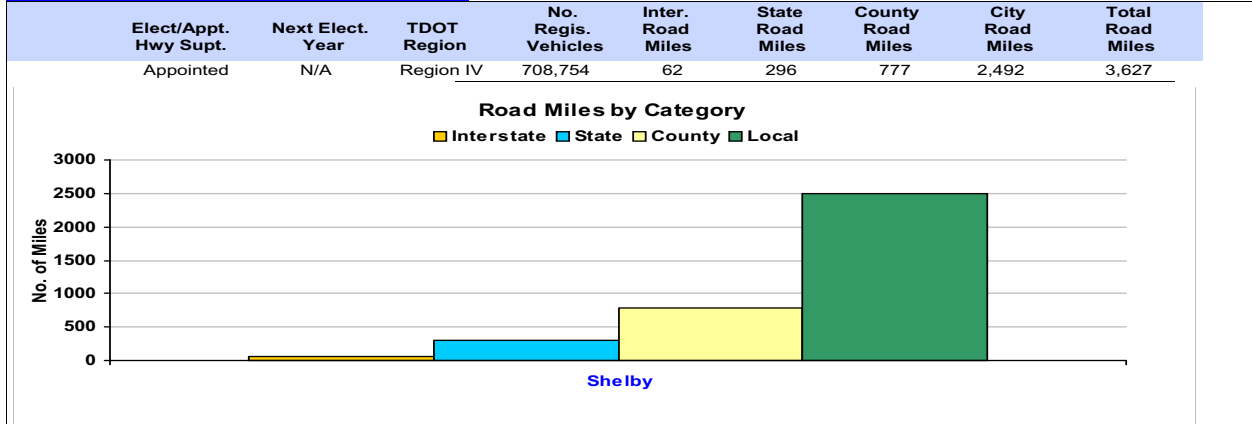
