Bledsoe County Seat - Pikeville

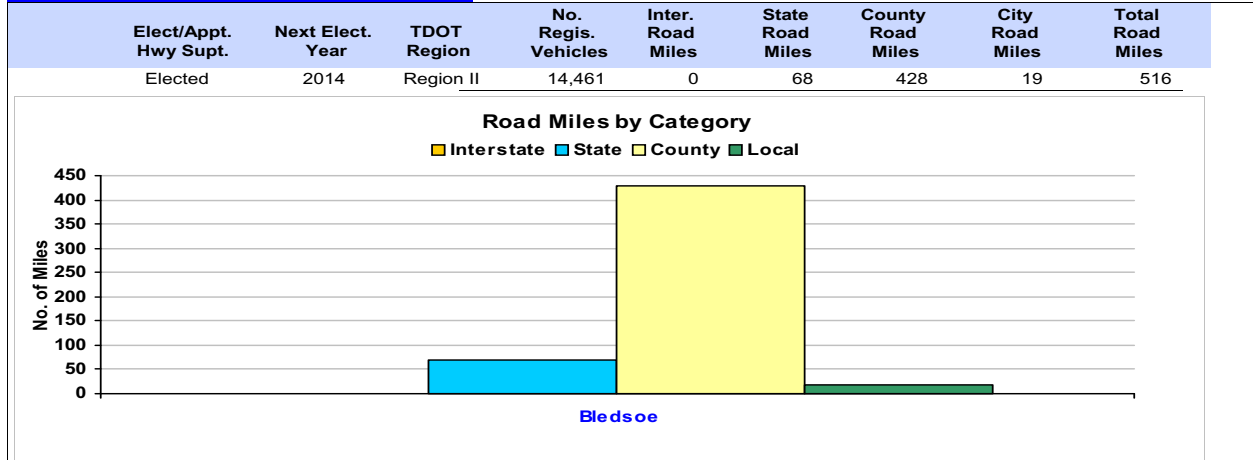
